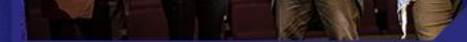

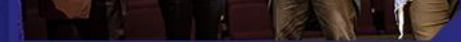

Eligibility to Stand for Election

Candidates must:-

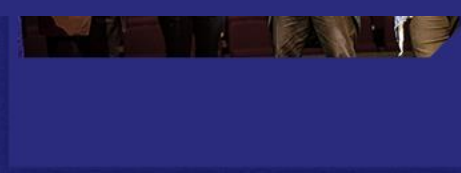
- Be aged 18 years or over
- Be on the Electoral Roll
- Be ordinarily resident in Guernsey
- Have been resident in Guernsey for previous two years or five years in total
- Meet the eligibility requirements in relation to criminal convictions

Nomination Period

- Opens at 9am - 12th May and closes at 4pm - 14th May
- Forms available from 22nd April – must be returned in person to the Bailiff's Office
- Must be signed by proposer and seconder, who must also be on the Roll
- Daily list of candidates nominated will be published by the Presiding Officer
- Candidates will receive a pack of information at this time

Electoral Roll

- Lists the name and address of each person registered to vote
- One free electronic copy of the Electoral Roll for campaigning
- May purchase up to two additional copies for each parish
- All Electoral Rolls must be returned after use
- Walk order Electoral Rolls available on request
- Data Protection Law will apply to candidates as Data Controllers

Candidate and Political Party expenditure

- Regulated period starts 31 March 2025 ends on 18 June
- Candidates and Political Parties can spend up to **£3,000** on their campaigns
- All election expenditure, including any arising before the regulated period starts, **must** be declared



Candidate and Political Party expenditure records

- Will be published
- Must be submitted to the CRO within 14 days of Election Day

Thursday 12th June at 4.00pm	Deadline for candidates to notify the Central Returning Officer that they wish to be present at the vote count
